






Figure 1. Static Characteristic




Figure 3. Collector-Emitter Saturation Voltage and Base-Emitter Saturation Voltage




Figure 5. Forward Biased Safe Operating Area




Figure 2. DC Current Gain




Figure 4. Collector Output Capacitance




Figure 6. Power Derating




Figure 7. 2-LEAD, TO263, D2PAK, SURFACE MOUNT
